Introduction

Certification under the PEFC Balkan Forest Certification System (BFCS) shall be carried out by Certification Body (CB) that posses accreditation issued by Accreditation Body (AB) that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).

In the process of building the PEFC BFCS, three PEFC National Governance Bodies (NGB's) were participating and accepted the PEFC Balkan Forest Certification System. In case a new member is joining to PEFC BFCS, this document shall not be revised, if they decide to accept the principles of the PEFC BFCS, and to adopt the scheme documentation outside of the FM standard.

The PEFC BFCS is facilitating the efforts of new countries willing to join the Balkan FC System and to support the PEFC global efforts for sustainable forest management.

In principle, Certification Bodies carrying out forest management certification shall be accredited by the AB that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).

In the countries participating in the PEFC BFCS and where national AB have not yet developed accreditation procedures, any AB that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) is eligible to operate forest management certification.

PEFC Notification establishes a necessary link between the accredited certification bodies and The Council for SFM and allows certification bodies to issue PEFC recognised certificates.

1. Scope

This document describes procedures for the issuance of notification by The Council for SFM to certification bodies operating:

- a) Forest Management certification against the requirements of the PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in North Macedonia and/or
- b) Chain of Custody certification in North Macedonia.

This document was approved by The Council for SFM and shall be applied for all certification bodies carrying out forest management and/or chain of custody certification in North Macedonia.

3. Terms and definitions

3.1 Accredited certificate

A certificate issued by a certification body within the scope of its accreditation which bears the accreditation body's symbol.

3.2 PEFC authorised body

An entity authorised by the PEFC Council to administer the PEFC scheme on behalf of the PEFC Council.

Note: The authorised body is either the PEFC National Governing Body (NGB) operating within its country or another entity which has been authorised by the PEFC Council to administer the PEFC scheme.

4. Conditions for notification by The Council for SFM

The certification body applying for notification by The Council for SFM shall:

- be a legal entity;
- agree to be listed on the publicly available, web based PEFC Information Register, including the certification body's identification data and / or other data as specified by the PEFC Council and/or The Council for SFM;
- sign a notification contract with The Council for SFM (Appendix 1).

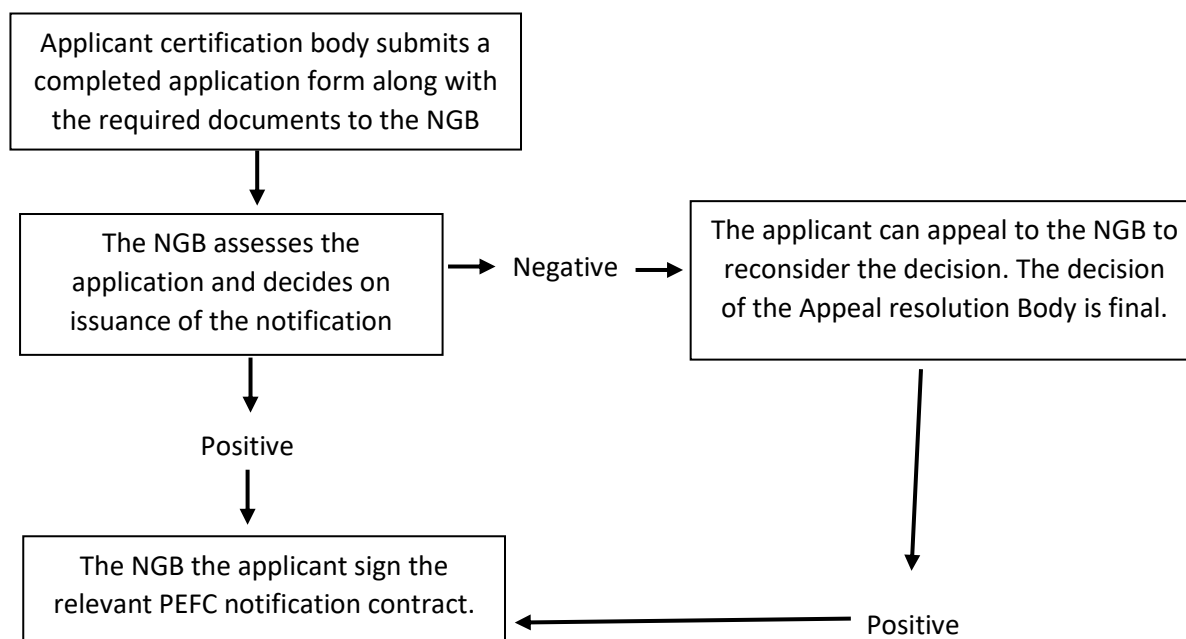
a) The certification body applying for notification for Forest Management certification under the Balkan Forest Certification System shall have valid accreditation, issued by Accreditation Body (NAB) that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).

The accreditation shall be issued against ISO/IEC 17021-1 (most recent version) and the scope of the accreditation shall explicitly include PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in North Macedonia.

b) The certification body applying for notification for Chain of Custody certification under the BFCS shall have valid accreditation, issued by an accreditation body that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for product certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF). The accreditation shall be issued against ISO/IEC 17065 (most recent version) and the scope of the accreditation shall explicitly include PEFC Standard, Chain of Custody of Forest and Tree Based Products – Requirements (most recent version), in its valid version.

The notification procedure does not include any discriminatory measures, such as the certification body's country of origin, affiliation to an association, etc.

5. Notification issuance procedures



6. Obligations of the notified certification body

The certification body (CB) notified by the The Council for SFM shall:

1. Pay The Council for SFM an annual notification fee for every certificate when issued by the CB. The amount of the fee is specified in Appendix 3, *Tariffs of the Notification Fee* and can be changed by The Council for SFM during the validity of the contract. Any change to the contract between The Council for SFM and the notified certification body resulting from a change in the rates will take effect the year following that in which The Council for SFM has informed the certification body, in writing, of the change.
2. Agree to be listed on the PEFC Find Certified online database, including the certification body's identification data and/or other data as may be specified by the PEFC Council and/or The Council for SFM.
3. Inform certificate holders about the range of information it is reported to The Council for SFM and that this information (except the certificate holders' turnover) will be made publicly available on the PEFC Find Certified online database.
4. Inform the certificate holder how to obtain a PEFC trademarks usage licence from The Council for SFM.

6.1. Forest management certification

The certification body notified by The Council for SFM for Forest Management certification shall:

1. Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC BS 04:2021, Certification and accreditation procedures and inform The Council for SFM immediately about any changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.

2. Carry out Forest Management certification against PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in North Macedonia within the scope of the valid accreditation.
3. Provide The Council for SFM immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form, as required by the PEFC Council, for each PEFC Forest Management certificate issued within the scope of notification and on changes concerning reported certificates.
4. Provide The Council for SFM, upon request, with a list of Forest Management certificates issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

6.2. Chain of Custody certification

The certification body notified by The Council for SFM for Chain of Custody certification shall:

1. Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC Standard, Requirements for Certification Bodies operating Certification against the PEFC International Chain of Custody Standard (most recent version) and inform The Council for SFM immediately about any changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.
2. Carry out PEFC chain of custody certification against PEFC Standard, Chain of Custody of Forest and Tree Based Products – Requirements (most recent version) within the scope of the valid accreditation.
3. Provide The Council for SFM immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form, as required by the PEFC Council, for each Chain of Custody certificate and every site covered by a multi-site certificate, issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM and on changes concerning reported certificates.
4. Provide The Council for SFM, upon request, with a list on certificates issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

6.3. Check on fulfillment of requirements of PEFC Trademarks Usage Rules

The certification body notified by The Council for SFM for Chain of Custody certification shall:

1. Carry out PEFC trademarks usage verification against PEFC Standard, PEFC Logo Usage Rules – Requirements (most recent version) and PEFC BS 07:2020 within the scope of the valid accreditation.
2. Provide The Council for SFM immediately and truthfully for PEFC trademarks use by certified entities issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM and on changes concerning reported certificates.

7. Validity of notification

The notification is valid for the period of the validity of the certification body's accreditation. The notification can be terminated or suspended immediately by The Council for SFM, if the notification contract is violated.

Annex 1

PEFC NOTIFICATION CONTRACT FOR FOREST MANAGEMENT

Between

- 1) The Council for sustainable forest management in the Republic of Macedonia, address Nikola Parapunov 41, building 5/III/307, Skopje
- and
- 2) *“Name and address of the certification body”* (hereafter certification body)

Whereas the Notified Certification Body is operating Forest Management certification recognised by The Council for sustainable forest management in the Republic of Macedonia (hereafter The Council for SFM);

Whereas The Council for SFM is the governing body of the PEFC Council, Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification schemes in North Macedonia, based on an administration contract signed with the PEFC Council;

Whereas the Notified Certification Body is to be granted notification, and The The Council for SFM recognises certificates issued by the Notified Certification Body within the scope of valid accreditation to organisations which are registered in North Macedonia.

Now, therefore the above said parties agree to the following:

Article 1: Definitions

1. Forest Management certification

This is PEFC MK 03:2020, PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in North Macedonia which forms part of the contractual documentation. The PEFC MK 03:2020 can be altered or replaced with another document by The Council for SFM.

2. Certification and Accreditation Procedures – Forest Management certification

This is PEFC BS 04:2021, Certification and accreditation procedures which forms part of the contractual documentation. PEFC BS 04:2021 can be altered or replaced with another document by The Council for SFM.

3. Tariffs of the Notification Fee of The Council for SFM.

These are the tariffs defined in Appendix 3 to *“Notification of Certification Bodies for Chain of Custody and Forest Management Certification against the requirements of the Balkan forest certification system”* which forms part of the contractual documentation and is found in the annex of this contract.

4. Certificate Reporting Form

This is Appendix 4 to *“Notification of Certification Bodies for Chain of Custody and Forest Management Certification against the requirements of the Balkan Forest Certification System”* which forms part of the contractual documentation and is found in the annex of this contract.

Article 2: Responsibilities of the Notified Certification Body

The Notified Certification Body is obliged to:

- a) Pay The Council for SFM an annual notification fee for every certificate when invoiced by The Council for SFM. The amount of the fees is specified in Appendix 3, *Tariffs of the Notification Fee of The Council for SFM* and can be changed by The Council for SFM during the validity of the contract.

Any change to the contract between The Council for SFM and the Notified Certification Body resulting from a change in the rates will take effect the year following that in which The Council for SFM has informed the Notified Certification Body, in writing, of the change.

b) Agree to be listed on the PEFC Find Certified online database, including the certification body's identification data and/or other data as may be specified by the PEFC Council and/or The Council for SFM.

c) Inform certificate holders about the range of information it is reporting/reported to The Council for SFM and that this information (except the certificate holders' turnover) will be made publicly available on the PEFC Find Certified online database.

d) Inform the certificate holder how to obtain a PEFC trademarks usage licence from The Council for SFM.

The Notified Certification Body carrying out Forest Management certification is obliged to:

e) Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC BS 04:2021 and inform The Council for SFM immediately about any changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.

f) Carry out Forest Management certification against PEFC MK 03:2020 within the scope of the valid accreditation.

g) Provide The Council for SFM immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form, as required by the PEFC Council, for each PEFC Forest Management certificate and every site covered by a group certificate, issued within the scope of PEFC Council notification and on changes concerning reported certificates.

h) Provide The Council for SFM, upon request, with a list of Forest Management certificates issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

Article 3: Responsibilities of The Council for SFM

1. The Council for SFM recognises the certificates issued by the Notified Certification Body in compliance with this contract and provides holders of the certificates with access to a PEFC Logo usage license under the conditions specified by The Council for SFM.

2. The Council for SFM is obliged to inform the Notified Certification Body of any changes to the regulations and documentation which affects this contract.

Article 4: Contract Termination

1. Either party may terminate the contract with three-month prior notice provided in writing and by registered letter to the last known address.

2. The Council for SFM may suspend the contract with immediate effect, if there are reasons to believe that any provision of the notification contract is not being adhered to.

3. Withdrawal, suspension or the end of the validity of the Notified Certification Body's accreditation, will result in automatic termination of the contract with effect on the same date as the withdrawal, suspension or the end of the validity of the accreditation.

4. The notification contract may be terminated in case of cancellation of the administration contract between The Council for SFM and the PEFC Council.

5. No notification fee is refunded to the Notified Certification Body in case of temporary suspension or termination of the contract according to the Article 4, bullet 1, 2 and 3.

6. The Council for SFM is not obliged to pay compensation for any costs or other damages which any temporary suspension or termination causes to the Notified Certification Body.

Article 5: Validity of the Contract

The contract enters into force when it has been signed by both parties.

Article 6: Data protection

To notify a certification body, The Council for SFM may collect some personal data on the individuals working for certification bodies. The personal data collected includes: full name of the contact person, email address and telephone number. This information is necessary for the normal operations of the PEFC certification system. They are made publicly available on the PEFC websites (PEFC Council website and PEFC National Governing Body websites), and The Council for SFM may share them with third parties limited to and exclusively for certification purposes. These data are indispensable to ensure the PEFC certification system operations, such as to trace validity of certificates, certification bodies notification and accreditation.

Personal data on individuals working for certification bodies are kept public for a duration of five (5) years after the end of the notification contract validity. Data will then be deleted. Upon request, The Council for SFM and PEFC Council may provide data subjects with information about the personal data it holds. Individuals working for certification bodies have the right to access or verify their personal data and to have them modified, transferred, corrected or deleted at any time. If the individuals working for certification bodies would like to exercise one of these data protection rights, they can contact the technical secretary or President of The Council for SFM at pefcmk@gmail.com.

By signing the PEFC notification contract, the individuals working for certification bodies agree to this data treatment procedure. In case the individuals working for certification bodies do not want this information to be publicly available, we encourage to provide generic contact details or the PEFC notification contract shall be cancelled.

Article 7: Governing Law - Jurisdiction

1. This contract is subject to the law of the country where The Council for SFM is registered.

2. Any disputes arising out of this agreement shall be finally and exclusively settled by the courts of North Macedonia.

Whereas the Notified Certification Body is operating Chain of Custody certification recognised by The Council for sustainable forest management in the Republic of Macedonia (hereafter The Council for SFM);

Whereas The Council for SFM is the national governing body in North Macedonia, based on an administration contract signed with the PEFC Council;

Whereas the Notified Certification Body is to be granted notification, and The Council for SFM recognises certificates issued by the Notified Certification Body within the scope of valid accreditation to organisations which are registered in North Macedonia, and international sites participating in multi-site Chain of Custody certifications of these organisations.

Now, therefore the above said parties agree to the following:

Article 1: Definitions

1. Chain of Custody of Forest Based Products – Requirements -

This is PEFC ST 2002:2020, Chain of Custody of Forest Based Products – Requirements, which forms part of the contractual documentation. PEFC ST 2002:2020 can be altered or replaced with another document by The Council for SFM.

2. Certification and Accreditation Procedures – Chain of Custody certification

This is PEFC ST 2003:2020, Requirements for Certification Bodies operating Certification against the PEFC International Chain of Custody Standard, which forms part of the contractual documentation and is found in the annex of this contract. PEFC 2003:2020 can be altered or replaced with another document by The Council for SFM.

3. Tariffs of the Notification Fee of The Council for SFM

These are the tariffs defined in Appendix 3 to “Notification of Certification Bodies for Chain of Custody and Forest Management Certification in North Macedonia against the requirements of the Balkan forest certification system” which forms part of the contractual documentation and is found in the annex of this contract.

4. Certificate Reporting Form

This is Appendix 4 to “Notification of Certification Bodies for Chain of Custody and Forest Management Certification in North Macedonia against the requirements of the Balkan forest certification system” which forms part of the contractual documentation and is found in the annex of this contract.

Article 2: Responsibilities of the Notified Certification Body

The Notified Certification Body is obliged to:

a) Pay The Council for SFM an annual notification fee for every certificate when invoiced by The Council for SFM. The amount of the fees is specified in Appendix 3, *Tariffs of the Notification Fee of The Council for SFM* and can be changed by The Council for SFM during the validity of the contract. e) Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC ST 2003:2020 and inform The Council for SFM immediately about any changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.

f) Carry out Chain of Custody certification against PEFC ST 2002:2020 within the scope of the valid accreditation.

g) Provide The Council for SFM immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form for each PEFC Chain of Custody certificate and every site covered by a group certificate, issued within the scope of PEFC Council notification and on changes concerning reported certificates.

h) Provide The Council for SFM, upon request, with a list of Chain of Custody certificates issued under the scope of notification by The Council for SFM, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

Article 3: Responsibilities of The Council for SFM

1. The Council for SFM recognises the certificates issued by the Notified Certification Body in compliance with this contract and provides holders of the certificates with access to a PEFC trademarks usage licence under the conditions specified by The Council for SFM.

2. The The Council for SFM is obliged to inform the Notified Certification Body of any changes to the regulations and documentation which affects this contract.

Article 4: Contract Termination

1. Either party may terminate the contract with three-month prior notice provided in writing and by registered letter to the last known address.

2. The The Council for SFM may suspend the contract with immediate effect, if there are reasons to believe that any provision of the notification contract is not being adhered to.

3. Withdrawal, suspension or the end of the validity of the Notified Certification Body's accreditation, will result in automatic termination of the contract with effect on the same date as the withdrawal, suspension or the end of the validity of the accreditation.

4. The notification contract may be terminated in case of cancellation of the administration contract between The Council for SFM and the PEFC Council.

5. No notification fee is refunded to the Notified Certification Body in case of temporary suspension or termination of the contract according to the Article 4, bullet 1, 2 and 3.

6. The The Council for SFM is not obliged to pay compensation for any costs or other damages which any temporary suspension or termination causes to the Notified Certification Body.

Article 5: Validity of the Contract

The contract enters into force when it has been signed by both parties.

Article 6: Data protection

To notify a certification body, The Council for SFM may collect some personal data on the individuals working for certification bodies. The personal data collected includes: full name of the contact person, email address and telephone number. This information is necessary for the normal operations of the PEFC certification system. They are made publicly available on the PEFC websites (PEFC Council website and PEFC National Governing Body websites), and The Council for SFM may share them with third parties limited to and exclusively for certification purposes. These data are indispensable to ensure the PEFC certification system operations, such as to trace validity of certificates, certification bodies notification and accreditation.

Personal data on individuals working for certification bodies are kept public for a duration of five (5) years after the end of the notification contract validity. Data will then be deleted. Upon request, The Council for SFM and PEFC Council may provide data subjects with information about the personal data it holds. Individuals working for certification bodies have the right to access or verify their personal data and to have them modified, transferred, corrected or deleted at any time. If the individuals working for certification bodies would like to exercise one of these data protection rights, they can contact the Technical secretary or President of The Council for SFM at pefcmk@gmail.com.

By signing the PEFC notification contract, the individuals working for certification bodies agree to this data treatment procedure. In case the individuals working for certification bodies do not want this information to be publicly available, we encourage to provide generic contact details or the PEFC notification contract shall be cancelled.

Article 7: Governing Law - Jurisdiction

1. This contract is subject to the law of the country where The Council for SFM is registered.

2. Any disputes arising out of this agreement shall be finally and exclusively settled by the courts of North Macedonia.

The Council for SFM charges amount of 0.02 EURO annually per hectare of forest certified by PEFC Forest Management standard(s).

The use of PEFC logo must be approved with a logo usage contract.

Note: The calculation of the notification fee takes into account the total forest area, regardless of co-ownership.

In case of multi-site certifications, which are not producer groups, the multi-site organisation's turnover is calculated as a sum of turnovers of sites covered by the multisite organisation.

National governing body issues the PEFC logo to certified companies free of charge. The contribution of companies is paid through a certification body, which collects the contribution for the institution.

The use of PEFC trademarks is free for certified COC companies. The PEFC trademarks use must be authorised with a PEFC trademarks usage contract.
